**PRESS RELEASE**

With the invaluable assistance from High Commission of India, Pretoria and Consulate General of India Johannesburg, and full cooperation of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Eswatini, Nine stranded Indians in Eswatini have been repatriated to India in a chartered Vande Bharat Mission flight on 25.07.2020 arranged by High Commission of India, Pretoria and Consulate General of India, Johannesburg for taking back stranded Indians from South Africa. The repatriated persons have reached India safely and are undergoing institutional quarantine for seven days. After completion of mandatory quarantine period, they will be proceeding to their respective hometowns.
